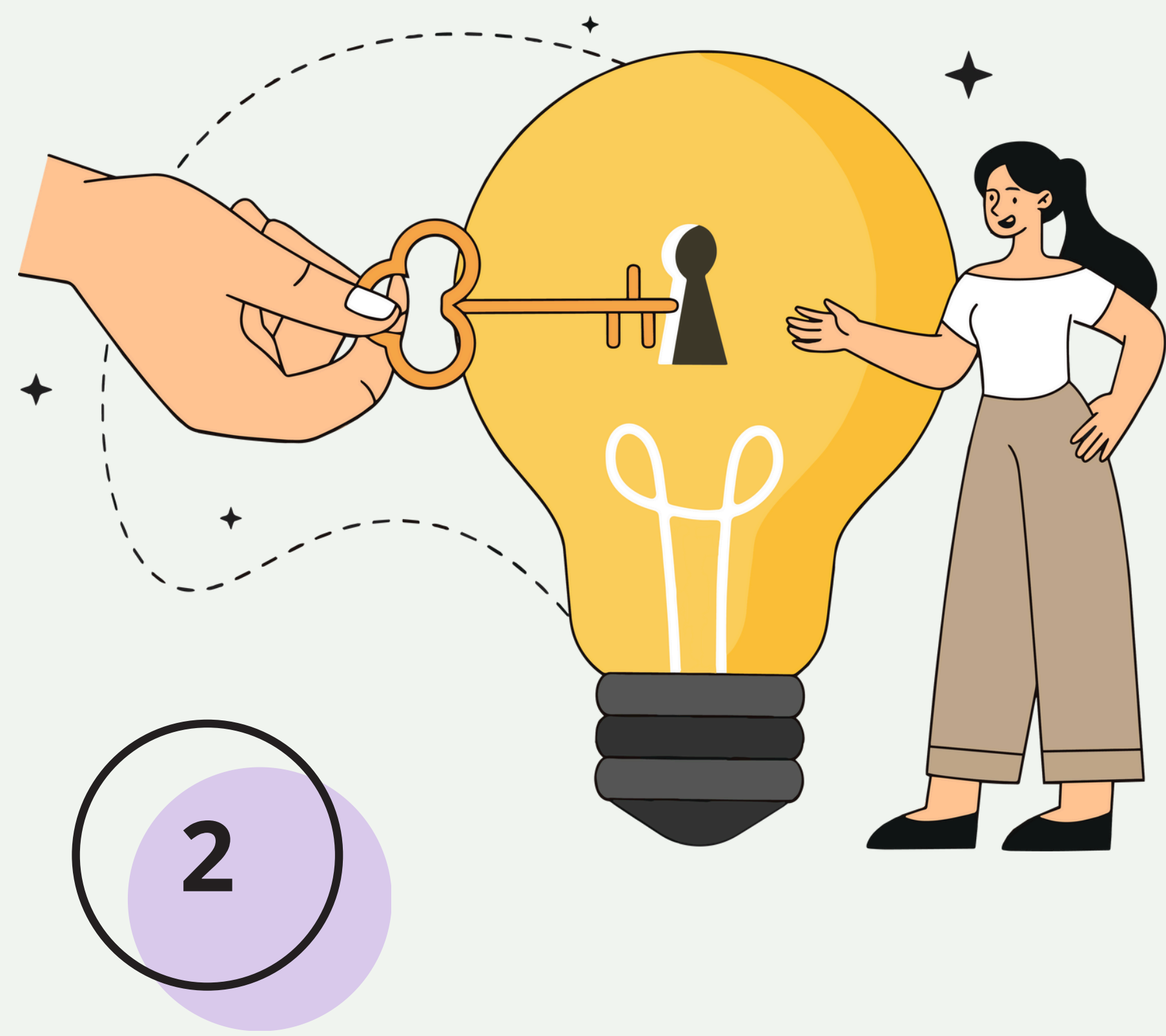

BENEFITS OF ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY



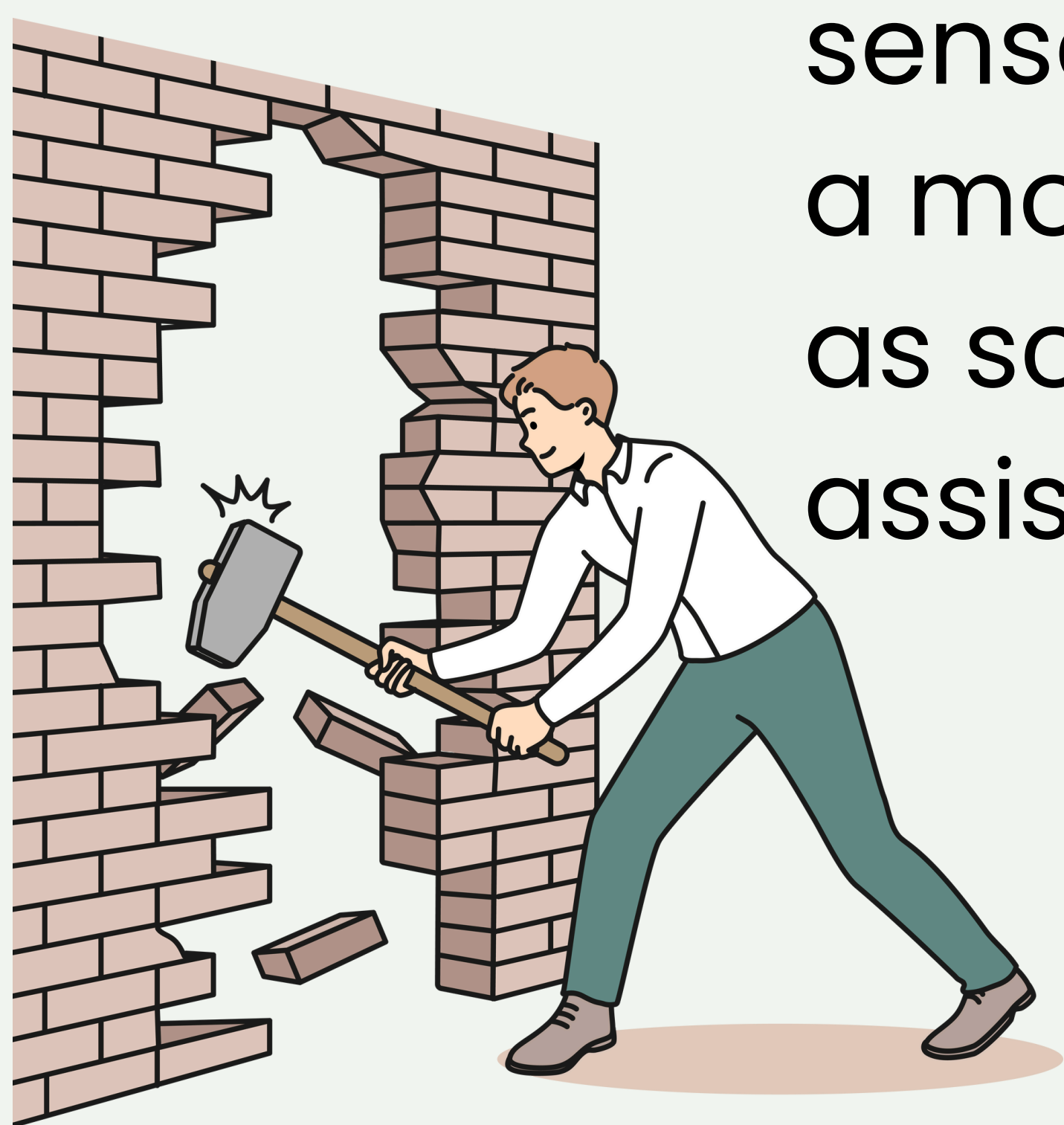
EXPANDING OPPORTUNITIES

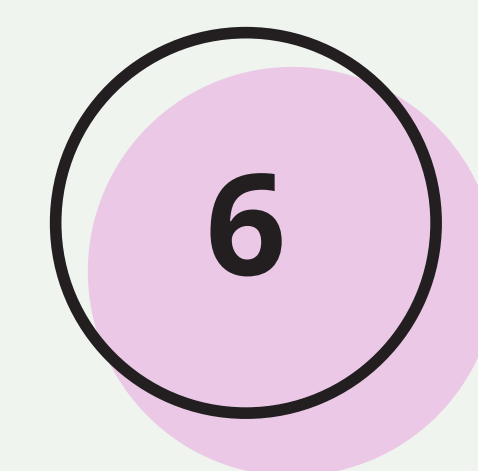
STRENGTHENS SOCIAL CONNECTIONS
